

The day before they were killed Clyde Barrow and Bonnie Parker ate several ham sandwiches at the Silver Moon, operated then by Otis Whatley on the Old Corsicana Road near Bellmead. Whatley now runs the Otis Bar, South Third on the city square. Turner, Frank Hardy and Hollis Hale are in Otis Bar almost daily now. Whatley told the late Deputy Sheriff Martin Brownlow a few minutes afterwards when he came to his place of business, about feeding Barrow and Parker. Brownlow said he was glad he didn't come in earlier. The deputy sheriff was killed in an auto collision at 4th and La Salle some years later.

The name of the town in Missouri where the bank was robbed in which the Wacoans participated was Ore Nage in Jasper county, near Joplin, Missouri. The town was named from the ore discovered in those parts. The bank robbery, resulted in a lot of shooting but very little money.
