The 1st (Colms') Battalion Tennessee Infantry, Companies A to E, was organized January 26, 1862. About November 1, 1862, it was temporarily consolidated with the 50th Regiment Tennessee Infantry, but each company of the two organizations was mustered separately and under its original designation during the period covered by this consolidation. By S. O. No. 45, A. & I. G. O., dated February 24, 1864, it was permanently consolidated with the 50th Regiment Tennessee Infantry and formed the 50th Regiment Tennessee Infantry (Consolidated), this company with Company D becoming Company K of the consolidated regiment.
